



Red brown

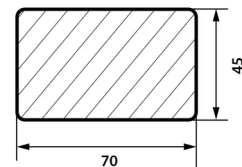
The Kapur comes from lowland tropical forests in Indonesia. Renowned for its durability, Kapur is a hard wood used for outdoor construction. It is often used as a substitute for Bangkirai. Kapur is initially reddish-brown to orange and quickly darkens to a brown color under the influence of UV rays. The chevron is made of laminated Kapur to give it perfect stability. It is necessary to cover the upper part with a sealing strip.
